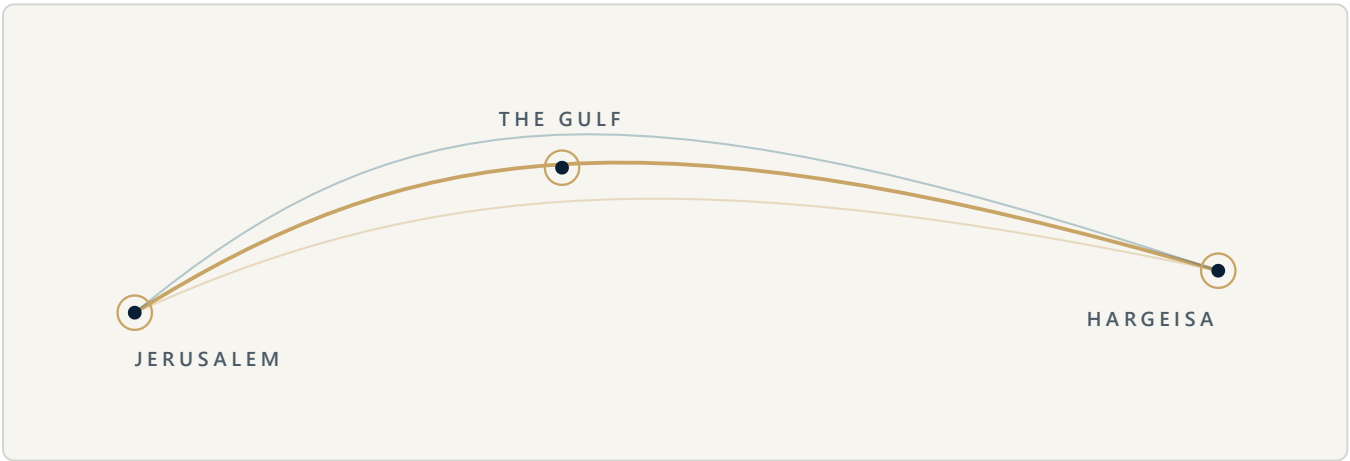
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WHY NOW

FOCUS AREAS · PART I

The essentials of a modern economy.

Our focus areas cover the foundations a growing economy is built on. Each is chosen for what it makes possible: energy that powers growth, water that sustains it, and ports that connect it to the world.



Solar Energy

Utility-scale solar generation to power homes, industry, and public services with clean, affordable energy.

Dependable power is the first condition of growth — the foundation every other sector builds on. We treat clean generation as the starting point of everything we intend to develop.



Clean Water

Treatment, storage, and distribution infrastructure that brings reliable, safe water to cities and communities.

Water security is public health, agriculture, and industry in one. We approach it as infrastructure that serves daily life from the ground up — dependable at the tap, not just at the source.



Marina & Ports

A new marina port on the Gulf of Aden — expanding Somaliland's gateway for trade, fishing, and tourism.

On one of the world's most strategic maritime crossings, the sea is Somaliland's front door. We intend to open it wider — for the vessels, visitors, and commerce a growing economy brings.

FOCUS AREAS · PART II

Connectivity, in the air and on the ground.

Connectivity — in the air, in data, and on the ground — turns a strategic location into a working economy. These focus areas complete the picture: aviation, data centers, and the roads and hospitals of daily life.



Aviation

Airport and aviation infrastructure connecting Somaliland to the Gulf, Africa, and the wider world.

Connections in the air shorten every distance on the ground — for trade, for investment, and for the people who carry both. Aviation is how an opening market joins the wider world.



Data Centers

The digital backbone of a connected economy — data centers and the foundations of a regional technology hub.

Modern economies run on data as surely as on power and water. We plan for the digital layer from the outset, so that growth in every other sector has somewhere to live.



Roads & Hospitals

The arteries of daily life: road networks that move people and goods, and hospitals that care for them.

Infrastructure is ultimately measured in daily life — the journey to market, the road to school, and the care that is there when it matters most.

A **pipeline of projects is being developed** across these focus areas, in step with national priorities.
